AMIDA: READER'S REPETITION: BEGINNING

Standing for Reader's Repetition of Amida

Ashkenazim commonly stand for the entire reader's repetition of the amida, but it is not the universal custom.

Adonai Sifatai by Prayer Leader

The prayer leader should say <u>Adonai sifatai</u>... quietly before saying the reader's repetition of the <u>amida</u> out loud.

Ki Shem by Prayer Leader

The prayer leader should not say $\underline{ki \ shem.}$.. at all since some people have the custom of not ever saying \underline{ki} $\underline{shem.}$...
