FORE-BLESSING (BRACHA RISHONA): INCORRECT BLESSING

Incorrect Fore-Blessing (Bracha Rishona) If Food Is/Is Not before You

- SITUATION You say the incorrect blessing over food in front of you but you also have a food in front of you that does fit the blessing.
- WHAT TO DO You may eat the food covered by your actual blessing, and then say the correct blessing for the food you originally intended to eat.
- NOTEYou may not go into a different room to find food that qualifies for the incorrect food blessing.You should instead say *Baruch shem kevod malchuto l'olam va'ed* as soon as possible.
- NOTE There is no specific time limit beyond which you may no longer say <u>Baruch shem kevod</u> malchuto l'olam va'ed.
