KASHRUT: DAIRY/MEAT: CUTTING BOARDS

Kashrut: Dairy/Meat: Cutting Boards

SITUATION You cut a spicy/<u>charif</u> item of one gender on a cutting board (whether wood or plastic), and

then cut the opposite-gender spicy/charif food on that same cutting board.

STATUS Generally, the board and the knife and whichever food was cut second becomes non-kosher.

Consult a *rabbi* for exceptions.

WHAT TO DO If you can sand off the surface to below the level of any knife cuts, the board might be kosher.

Consult a rabbi.
