When Shiv'a Ends: Onen

An <u>onen</u> ends <u>shiv'a</u> (and <u>shloshim</u>) with the household head ("<u>gadol ha'bayit</u>"--whoever controls the money in that household)—even if the household head begins <u>shiv'a</u> before burial and the <u>onen</u> joins the <u>shiv'a</u> house after burial.

When Shiv'a Ends: Non-Onen Who Finds Out Later

If you do not hear about someone's death for 30 days after the person died, observe just one day of <u>shiv'a</u>. If you hear in less than 30 days, observe the regular seven-day <u>shiv'a</u>.
