Synagogue Seat When Mourning for Parent

Change your normal seat in <u>synagogue</u> during the year of mourning for a parent. (The <u>rabbi</u> is not required to change seats). You should move to a seat further away from the <u>aron</u> hakodesh then your previous seat (since seats further from the <u>aron</u> are considered to be less prestigious than those close to the <u>aron</u>).

REASON This is to show humility and that we feel subdued due to the death.
