Saying Mincha after Lighting Jewish Festival Candles

A woman who has already lit <u>Jewish festival</u> candles may not say <u>mincha</u> for the afternoon before a <u>Jewish festival</u>, even if she lit (after <u>plag ha'mincha</u>) long before sunset time, unless she intended not to begin the <u>Jewish festival</u> when she was lighting the candles (and intending to begin later should only be done in urgent situations, not routinely.)
