When You May Speak after Kiddush

You may speak, even without having drunk anything yourself, once:

- The leader (mevareich) has said <u>Jewish festival</u> (or <u>Shabbat</u>) <u>kiddush</u> for other people, and
- At least 2 fl. oz. (59 ml) of the wine (or other appropriate beverage) over which <u>kiddush</u> was made has been drunk.
