Jewish Festivals: Opening Metal Bottle Caps

You may not open metal bottle caps on <u>Jewish festivals</u> if a metal ring will be left after doing so. You may break that ring or simply open the bottle before the <u>Jewish festival</u> (or simply open the bottle and reclose it such that when you open in again, no metal will be broken).

NOTE If you need the contents for a <u>Jewish festival</u> (such as if it is a bottle of wine), you may ask a non-Jew to open the bottle for you. But if it is wine that is not cooked/<u>meyushal</u>, the wine will become non-kosher once opened and handled by the non-Jew.
