Ya'aleh V'Yavo on Rosh Chodesh

If you forgot (or are not sure if you said) <u>ya'aleh v'yavo</u> of:

Rosh Chodesh Ma'ariv

Don't repeat the amida. This applies to both ma'arivs on a two-day Rosh Chodesh.

Rosh Chodesh Shacharit or Mincha

- If you forgot: Repeat the <u>amida</u> of <u>Rosh Chodesh</u> shacharit or mincha.
- If you are not sure: Repeat the <u>amida</u> with the condition that if you had said <u>ya'aleh</u> <u>v'yavo</u> the first time, the second time is a voluntary prayer (<u>tefilat nedava</u>).

NOTE If <u>Rosh Chodesh</u> falls on <u>Shabbat</u> and you are not certain whether you said <u>ya'aleh v'yavo</u> at <u>shacharit</u> or <u>mincha</u>, you must repeat the <u>amida</u> without a condition.
