Sukkot: Sleeping at Someone Else's House

If you sleep at another person's house or <u>sukka</u> during <u>Sukkat</u>, you should consider their <u>sukka</u> as being yours. You do not say the blessing <u>leisheiv ba'sukka</u> except if you eat bread or <u>mezonot</u> there.
