## **Kashrut: Dairy/Meat: Baking at Same Time: Solid, UNCOVERED**

<u>L'chatchila</u>, you should not bake uncovered <u>dairy</u> and meat foods in the same oven at the same time, even if both pans:

- Are non-liquid, AND
- Do not touch each other.

*B'di'avad*, both uncovered pans remain *kosher*—even if they touch each other, if both pans:

- Are non-liquid,
- Are clean and dry (on the outside), AND
- Do not contain spicy/charif food.

## **Example**

## **SITUATION**

- Food in both pans is solid.
- One pan is covered, one pan is uncovered.
- Both pans are clean and dry on outside.
- No spicy/charif.

**STATUS** 

They are both kosher b'dia'vad.
