Kashrut: Dairy/Meat: Hot Spills and Opposite Gender Utensil: Unused

SITUATION

- Hot food of one gender spills (falls into or onto) an empty utensil of the opposite gender.
- $\bullet\,$ The utensil was unused at 120° F (49° C) or more for at least 24 hours.

STATUS

- The utensil is usually non-kosher.
- The food is *kosher*.

NOTE

If the spill is spicy/<u>charif</u> or if the utensil had been used hot within the 24 hours before the spill, consult a rabbi.
