When To Bow toward Jerusalem

Normally, when saying the <u>amida</u>, or bowing at any other prayers such as <u>kaddish</u>, <u>alenu</u>, and <u>bar'chu</u>:

- If you are in a room with an ark (<u>aron kodesh</u>), face the ark—even if the ark is NOT in the same direction as Jerusalem.
- If you are not in a room with an ark, face Jerusalem during the <u>amida</u>. You do not need to face Jerusalem when bowing at any other times except during the <u>amida</u>.
