When To Say Mekadeish et Shimcha BaRabim

You may only include God's name in <u>Baruch ata Adonai</u>, <u>mekadeish et shimcha ba'rabim</u> if:

- You have not yet said the full morning shema, and
- It is still before the third <u>halachic hour</u> of the day.

NOTE

If you already said the morning *shema*, whether on time or not, you may still return to fill in the morning blessings. When you get to *l'olam yihei adam*, don't include God's name in the concluding blessing. Rather, say, "*Baruch ata*, *mekadeish et shimcha ba'rabim*."
