

When To Say Mekadeish et Shimcha BaRabim

You may only include God's name in Baruch ata Adonai, mekadeish et shimcha ba'rabim if:

- You have not yet said the full morning shema, and
- It is still before the third halachic hour of the day.

NOTE

If you already said the morning shema, whether on time or not, you may still return to fill in the morning blessings. When you get to l'olam yihei adam, don't include God's name in the concluding blessing. Rather, say, “*Baruch ata, mekadeish et shimcha ba'rabim.*”
