Introduction: Amida: Errors: Amida Additions

If you forgot to say, or incorrectly said, a phrase in the amida, you must correct your errors in:

- Mashiv ha'ruach
- <u>Ha'el ha'kadosh</u>
- Tein bracha/Tein tal u'matar l'vracha
- Ya'ale v'yavo (except Rosh Chodesh night).

Do not correct errors in other additions/changes if you have already said the blessing for that paragraph, such as:

- <u>Rosh Hashana</u>, <u>Yom Kippur</u>, and <u>Ten Days of Repentance</u> changes (except <u>ha'melech ha'</u> <u>kadosh)</u>
- Al ha'nisim
- Aneinu
- Ya'ale v'yavo (if Rosh Chodesh night).

NOTE You may correct any prayer error within 2.5 seconds of making it.

NOTE If you omitted part of the <u>amida</u> that would normally require you to repeat the <u>amida</u>, you do not need to repeat the <u>amida</u> if you intend (have <u>kayana/</u>concentrate from the beginning of the reader's repetition until the end of the repetition) to have your <u>amida</u> covered by the reader's repetition.
