How To Cover the Challot

On <u>Shabbat</u> (and <u>Jewish festivals</u>), you should place a white cover above the <u>challot</u> and another below (unless you have a white tablecloth).

REASON To recall the layers of dew above and below the <u>mun</u> that the Israelites ate for 40 years

in the desert.

NOTE If you have a fancy or beautiful cover for your *challa* that is not white underneath, you

may put a white cloth or paper towel between the cover and the challa in order to have

a white cover above the challa.
