Shabbat: Squeezing, Dabbing, and Smearing Medicinal Creams

You may squeeze a tube of cream on *Shabbat*, but you might not be able to use the cream on *Shabbat* for other reasons—consult a *rabbi*.

NOTE Smearing creams or ointments is permitted only in life-threatening situations.

Otherwise, you may not smear cream on skin on Shabbat (or a Jewish festival) even

using a shinu'i such as using the back of your hand or a toe.

Dabbing is permitted, but only when you are permitted to use medicine for that

purpose.

EXAMPLE You may dab cream on *Shabbat* for a bee sting.

REASON The pain from the sting will affect the entire body.

EXAMPLE You may not use cream for a mosquito bite.

REASON It is only a local irritation.

NOTE You may not smear cream for either condition.
