Responding to Prayer Leader before Elohai Netzur

NOTE

You have finished saying the final <u>amida</u> blessing "<u>...ha'mevareich et amo Yisrael</u> <u>ba'shalom</u>," but you have not yet said <u>Elohai neztur</u>.... You now need to respond to the prayer leader when he says <u>kaddish</u>, <u>kedusha</u>, blessings, or <u>modim</u>.

WHAT TO DO Quickly say the line "Yihiyu l'ratzon imrei phi...." and then you may reply to all parts of the public prayer, except that you may not say "Baruch hu u'varuch shemo." Then you may say Elohai netzur.

If you need to say the mourner's *kaddish*, say the entire line of *Yihiyu l'ratzon imrei phi* and then say mourner's *kaddish*. You may step back at *Oseh shalom* in *kaddish* and then, after completing saying *kaddish*, you may say *Elohai netzur*.
