When To Say Blessing over New Fruit Blossoms

The first time each year that you see blossoms on an edible-fruit tree, say the blessing "<u>shelo chisar</u> <u>ba'olamo davar</u>...." It may be anytime throughout the year, not only in <u>Nisan</u>. If you live in a region in which fruit trees blossom all year round, you should say "<u>shelo chisar</u>"... in <u>Nisan</u> after you see some new blossoms.

NOTE You may say the blessing on a single tree, even though the blessing says "trees" (plural).
